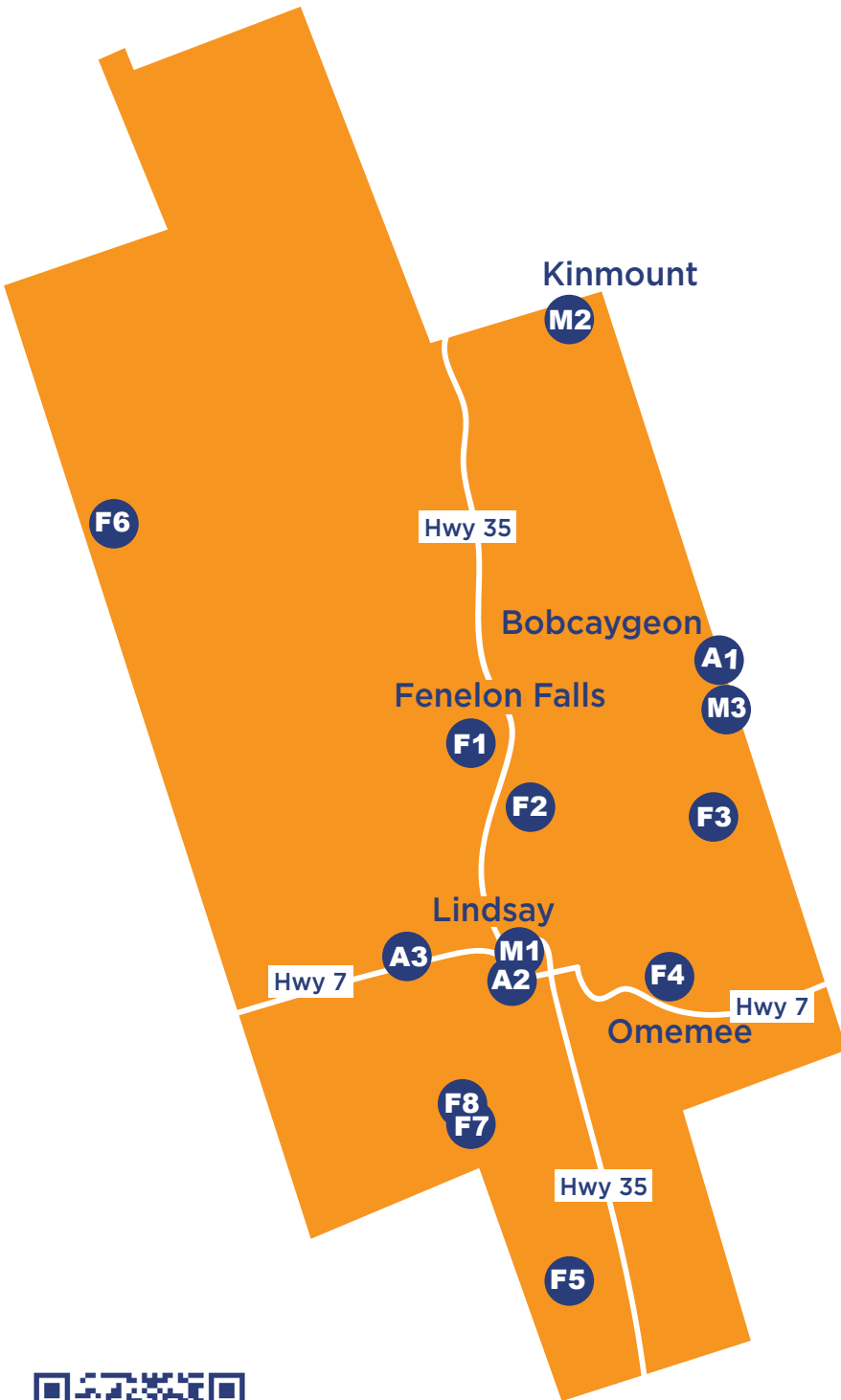

Farm Sites

F1 Organicfest at O'Brienview Organic Farm

Walk in through pastures to get up close with Belgian Blue/Black Angus and Wagyu beef cattle and calves. Visit with the free ranging chickens. See vegetables in the greenhouse and gardens all grown organically on the family farm. Bring a cooler to stock up on frozen beef, chicken, and fresh vegetables.

Ongoing: Interact with cattle and poultry, and see organic vegetables growing. Learn about organic farming. Buy produce and frozen organic meat.

Location: 688 Country Lane, Cameron; Go north from Highway 35 or south from Glenarm Road onto Country Lane.

F2 Sheepfest at Crow Hill Farm

Visit our registered Corriedale Sheep flock, a dual purpose breed for both meat and wool. Children can collect fresh eggs from our hen house. Watch a wool spinning demonstration, and try your hand at Drop Spindle Spinning in a hands-on experience. Frozen lamb, honey, maple products and eggs for sale from our farm gate stand. Also available for purchase are Corriedale Handspinning Fleeces. Property is accessible.

Ongoing: Sheep in our pastures, wool spinning, educational displays, egg collecting.

F3 Pigfest at Three Forks Farm

Take a walking tour of our farm and visit our piglets, laying hens, sheep and pigs socializing out on pasture. Our sows (mama pigs) are especially social and always looking for a snack when they see visitors. Chat with our volunteers and farmers to learn more about our farm/homestead in peak harvest season. You can also wander through our garden and our greenhouse to see the final weeks of fall veggies growing. Lunch available - enjoy a sausage hot off the grill or come prepared with a cooler and take some delicious, pasture raised frozen chicken, lamb or pork cuts home with you. We will also have garlic, eggs and select vegetables available for purchase.

Ongoing: Piglets, pigs, sheep and chickens available for easy viewing. BBQ sausage on a bun, eggs, garden veggies and preserves for sale.

F4 Mazefest at McQuaid's Country Market

Get lost in the 9-acre corn maze (\$), enjoy family-friendly games, and capture memories at photo ops scattered in the area. Learn how pumpkins grow, then take a wagon ride (\$) to the pumpkin patch to pick your perfect pumpkin. Finish the selfie scavenger hunt, then visit the market stand, with over 50 kinds of pumpkins, squash and gourds. Don't miss the homemade jams, jellies, relishes and salsas, and farm-raised beef and eggs. Honey, maple syrup, fudge and fresh cheese curds from other local producers will also be available.

Ongoing: Selfie scavenger hunt, learn how a pumpkin grows, farm products available to purchase.

F5 Veggiefest at Lunar Rhythm Garden

Tour the 15 acre Pro-Cert certified organic vegetable farm dedicated to growing 75 varieties of vegetables in the field and with high tunnels and greenhouses. Cultivation is powered by four heavy draft horses. Visit the cows and calves, pigs, miniature horses and chickens. Visitors can see the cold storage, greenhouses and vegetable wash station. Guided tours of the farm will be available. Visit Farm Star Petting zoo (by donation) to sit with bunnies, groom miniature horses, and lead the goats. Fresh organic produce, meat, honey and apples will be available for purchase.

Ongoing: Tours of the vegetable fields and high tunnels, visit animals, petting zoo entry by donation (\$), purchase farm fresh produce, honey, apples, and frozen meats.

F6 Maplefest at The Roost Farm
