Look for on-farm experiences. Several farms have interactive, educational and taste experiences which can be purchased in addition to general admission.

Site F1 - Organicfest at O'Brienview Organic Farm

Walk out in our pastures to get up close with our Belgian Blue x Black Angus cattle & calves. Visit with Heritage Berkshire pigs, chickens, ducks and turkeys, all raised organically on our family farm. Stay for lunch to taste our famous sausage on a bun or hamburger. Bring a cooler to stock up on our frozen beef, pork, and chicken or fresh vegetables.

Visit our registered Corriedale sheep flock, a dual purpose breed for both meat and wool. See our honeybee yard and the honey room. Collect fresh eggs from our hen house. Frozen lamb, honey, maple products and eggs for sale from our farm gate stand. Also available for purchase are Corriedale Hand-Spinning Fleeces. Property is accessible.

Site F3 - Pigfest at Three Forks Farm

Take a walking tour of our site to see pasture raised chickens, turkeys, pigs and hopefully some piglets! Learn about how and why we raise our animals on pasture. Our farm features mixed heritage breed pigs (Tamworth, Berkshire, Hampshire) on rotational pastures. Participate in an egg collecting activity and nature crafting. Be sure to bring your cooler to take home our frozen chicken and pork cuts which will be available for sale. Stay for our own BBQ sausage on a bun and cold drinks for lunch!

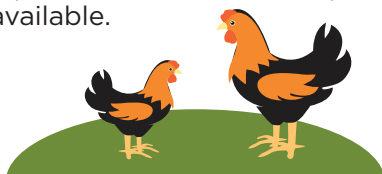

Site F4 - Veggiefest at Lunar Rhythm Gardens

Tour our 15-acre Pro-Cert certified organic vegetable farm. We grow over 75 varieties of vegetables in fields cultivated by heavy draft horses with the aid of high tunnels and greenhouses. Visitors can see the cold storage, greenhouse and vegetable wash station.

- 11:00am - Potato digging, then pick a bag of potatoes to take home. (\$5)
- 3:00pm - View heavy draft horses cultivating the vegetable field.

• Ask a volunteer for a guided pick-your-own flowers or vegetables experience. Depending on availability. (\$5) Fresh organic produce is available for purchase. Washrooms available.

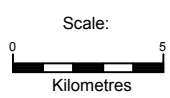
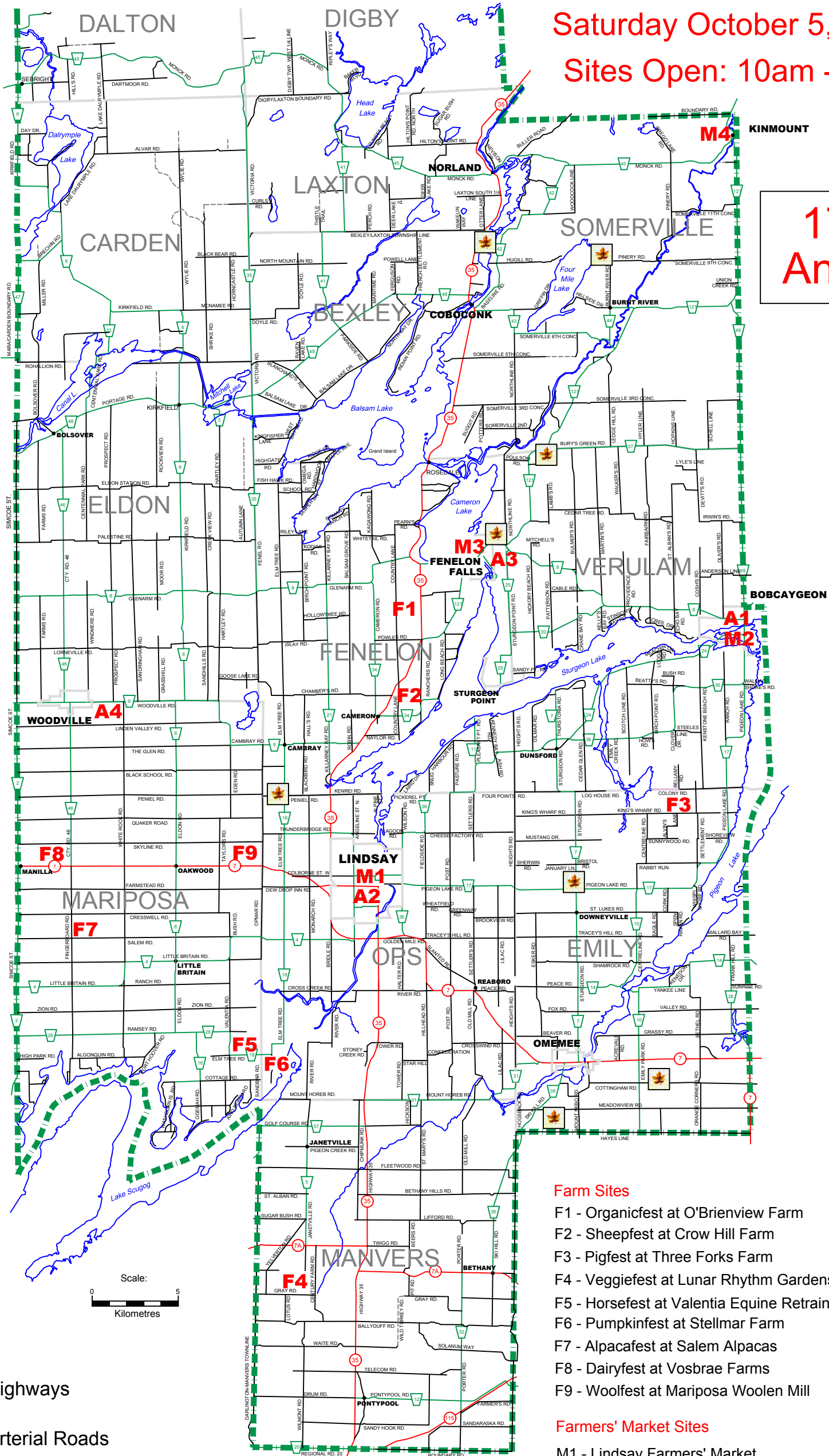
