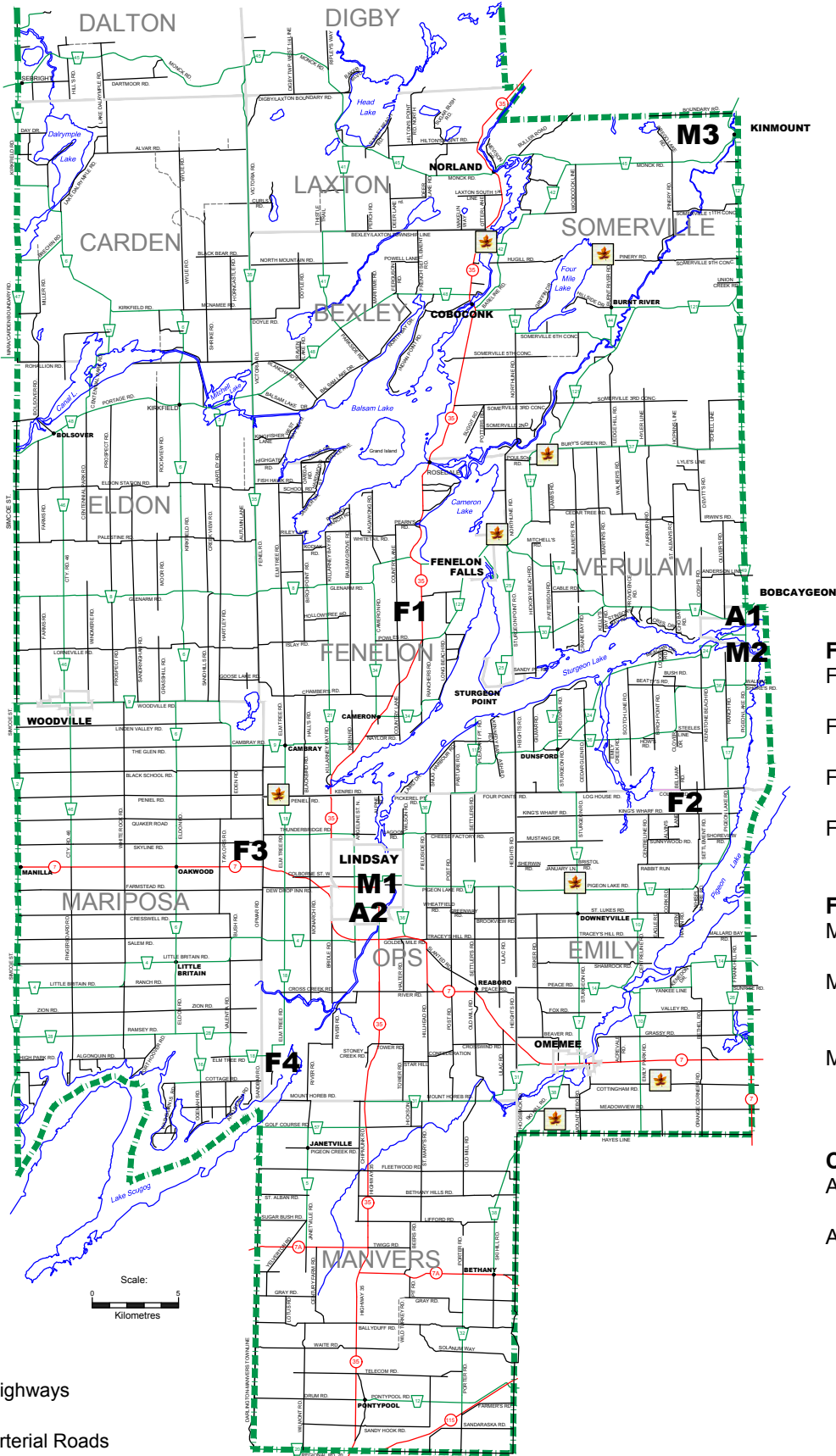

Farm Sites

F1: Organicfest at O'Brienview Organic Farm

Walk out in our pastures to get up close with our Belgian Blue/Black Angus and Waygu cattle & calves. Visit with Heritage Berkshire pigs, chickens, and ducks, see vegetables in the gardens all grown organically on our family farm. Stay for lunch to taste our famous hamburgers. Bring a cooler to stock up on our frozen beef, chicken and fresh vegetables.

Ongoing: Interact with cattle, pigs and poultry. Learn about organic farming. Buy organic meat & produce.

F2: Pigfest at Three Forks Farm

Take a walking tour of our site to see pasture raised chickens, turkeys, pigs and hopefully some piglets! Learn about how and why we raise our animals on pasture. We have mixed heritage breed pigs (Tamworth, Berkshire, Hampshire) on rotational pastures. Be sure to bring your cooler to take home our frozen chicken and pork cuts which will be available for sale.

Ongoing: We will have pigs in a front pasture and turkeys available for easy viewing.

F3: Woolfest at Mariposa Woolen Mill

Visit a working wool mill and traditional farm to learn about the process of making wool yarn, and batting for felting. Walk through our mill to see the wool fibres at different stages, then explore our local wool history exhibit. See heritage breeds of sheep and a loveable pig in the front pasture. Our farm market shop will feature finished wool products, Mariposa Dairy cheeses as well as frozen farm raised meats, fresh produce and local goods. Property is accessible.

Ongoing: See wool being processed into yarn, cording, or batting. Local wool history, animals in pasture, and farm market store.

F4: Pumpkinfest at Stellmar Farm

See giant pumpkins and visit the craft tent at Stellmar Farm, which features a wide selection including: pumpkins, squash, gourds, fall decorations, flower arrangements, decorative corn, wreaths, fall crafts, gourd art, preserves, honey and tasty pumpkin bread. Try your luck at guessing the weight of a giant pumpkin to win a gift basket. Perhaps even learn the secret behind growing giant pumpkins! Try out our full line of homemade soaps, body butters, and lotions: many products contain our own beeswax and honey. New this year, for an additional fee of \$3 per person or \$10 per family of 4 or more, take a tour through our one-way Corn Maze. Washrooms available.
