The following information is for an Annual Permit:

Permission will be considered to move Oversize Loads throughout the effective period indicated on the Certificate of Insurance of the Mover on all City roads within the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes during the hours/days indicated below.

Category 1:

- Width of load is greater than 8.7 feet (2.6 metres) and less than 11 feet (3.35 metres).
- Height of load is greater than 13.8 feet (4.15 metres) and less than 14 feet 2 inches (4.26 metres).
- No restriction on time of move

Category 2:

- Width of load is less than 12 feet 2 inches (3.7 metres).
- Height of load is greater than 14 feet 2 inches (4.26 metres).
- Daylight hours only. Not permitted on weekends or statutory holidays.

If the dimensions of the load you are moving exceed Category 1 and 2 you will require a Single Move Permit. See below.

Oversize/Overweight Load Permit Requirements and Restrictions:
Please read carefully.

- Submit the completed application via email or fax together with the Certificate of Insurance and payment at least **two (2) business days** prior to the move.
- The City of Kawartha Lakes requires the applicant to provide a Certificate of Insurance evidencing "Comprehensive General Liability" insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence including bodily injury, personal injury, contractual liability, non-owned automobile and cross liability and severability of interest clauses. The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes shall be named as an "Additional Insured" under the policy for the purpose of permit activities.
- The City of Kawartha Lakes requires the applicant to provide a Certificate of Insurance evidencing Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000.00 including all automobiles owned or leased by the insured/applicant.
- If at anytime the above noted policies of insurance are cancelled or materially changed in any manner for any reason during the period of coverage as stated above, so as to affect the Certificate of Insurance, thirty (30) days prior written notice, by registered mail, will be given by the Insurer to the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes.
- In consideration of the issuance of this permit and other good and valuable consideration, the applicant, their heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless the Corporation of the City Kawartha Lakes, from any action, claim, damages, costs (including legal costs) or loss whatsoever, arising from operations carried out under this permit.
- The City of Kawartha Lakes reserves the right to inspect any load at any time at its sole discretion.
- This permit does not apply to roads or structures with posted load limitations.
- Oversize loads transported on City roads without posted load limitations shall be subject to M.T.O. permit conditions with regard to axel loading, including seasonal limitations.
- It is the permit holder's responsibility as relates to the height of the load (loaded), as the City of Kawartha Lakes has some banners that are 4.2 metres high.
- The applicant is advised that this permit is void on any City road under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes that are under construction at the time of the move.
- The person or company for whom this permit is issued agrees to hold harmless the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes for any damage which may result from the movement of the oversize load or object, and indemnify the City for damage caused to City property.
- The Permit holder:
 - must contact any affected utility company at least 48 hours prior to the move to arrange for any protection or alteration of their facilities;

- is responsible to arrange for personal or police escort, if required;
- is responsible for flags/markers on overhanging loads;
- is responsible to ensure that any overhead obstructions are clear;
- is responsible for checking their proposed route prior to commencing their move to ensure there are no obstructions of any kind;
- is solely responsible to ensure that all applicable municipal, provincial and federal laws, regulations and acts shall be complied with at all times including but not limited to, all employees, owners and sub-contractors utilized by the permit holder.
