The Ministry of the Environment and Conservation and Parks (MECP) has received your letter dated March 28, 2019 and revised letter and notice May 10, 2019 requesting approval for public notice as an alternative to non-residential area signs for the use of Clearview Herbicide (Reg. # 29752) and Gateway Adjuvant (Reg. # 31470) for noxious weed control on rural roadsides, and Credit Xtreme Herbicide (Reg. #29888), Clearview Herbicide (Reg. #29752), Gateway Adjuvant (Reg. #31470) and Arsenal Powerline Herbicide (Reg. #30203) for guiderail vegetation control in the Kawartha Lakes.

Pursuant to section 79 of Ontario Regulation 63/09 under the *Pesticides Act*, your request to provide alternative means of public notice of pesticide use has been considered and approval of public notice, as set out below, is granted:

- Notices must be published **at least seven days** before beginning pesticide application operations.
- Notices are to be published in a prominent location in the newspapers of general circulation and must be printed such that they are at least 10 cm (4 inches) in width.
- Actual pages of the newspaper containing the newspaper notices (including the name of the publication and the publication date) must be forwarded to the MECP office 1259 Gardiners Road, Kingston, Ontario K7M 8S5, Attention: **Scott Olan**, Regional Pesticides Specialist **within thirty days of publication**. Alternatively, scanned copies can be sent by email to **Scott.Olan@ontario.ca**.
- The notice is to be posted on the City's website.



- Approval is valid until September 7, 2019.

Please note that areas which pedestrians access on a regular basis or other areas where the public is invited to stop including rest areas or picnic areas are not included as public thoroughfares under section 79(3) of O. Reg. 63/09.
