

Call for Citizen Appointments

The City of Kawartha Lakes invites applications from members of the public who are interested in being a **Municipal Livestock Predation Investigator** or **Fence Viewer**.

Applicant Eligibility:

- a Canadian citizen
- 18 Years of Age or Older
- residency in the City of Kawartha Lakes preferred, but not required

Position	Number of members required
<p>Municipal Livestock Predation Investigator – appointed pursuant to the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program to make a full investigation and submit a report pursuant to the Program. Investigators are paid \$60.00 per report plus mileage. Successful appointees may expect completing 2 to 20 claims per year for each time a livestock producer in their area contacts them directly due to a loss of livestock from wildlife or dogs. Each claim will require Investigators to collect evidence on site at the farm, and prepare and submit a report of the predation. Applicants should demonstrate experience in raising livestock, predation investigation, livestock valuation, livestock veterinary care, or wildlife tracking and identification.</p>	<p>Up to 9 for the term of Council (2023 to 2026)</p>

Position	Number of members required
<p>Fence Viewers – appointed pursuant to the Line Fences Act, appointees are paid \$70.00 per site visit plus mileage. Successful appointees may expect to participate in one Fence Viewing per year alongside two other Fence Viewers, when scheduled by the Clerk’s Office to adjudicate a dispute regarding a fence on a property line. Appointees will hear out evidence on site from property owners, and prepare an ‘award’ to resolve the issues. Applicants should demonstrate experience with fence viewing, agriculture, fence construction, property law, or surveying.</p>	<p>Up to 9 for the term of the Council (2023 to 2026)</p>

Applicants for both positions will be required to access remote areas on rural properties, must hold a valid “G” driver’s licence, and be willing to sign a Code of Conduct and Ethics.
