

Homelessness Winter Response

Landlord Assistance

With the snow and cold weather fast approaching, the City of Kawartha Lakes is looking to partner with Kawartha Lakes and Haliburton landlords to help those who are homeless.

Incentives include:

- Funding to help prepare the unit for move-in
- Tenant choice
- Last months rent guarantee
- Two months of pre-paid rent
- Assistance with financial issues that may arise (e.g. rent arrears)
- Compensation for damages that are beyond regular wear and tear
- Monthly check-ins with landlords
- Weekly (at minimum) check-ins with tenants
- A single point of contact to address concerns

*An itemized list of repairs, including cost, must be submitted to the City for review and approval. Pictures of the repairs, before and after, are required. Compensation for damages is limited to once a year and available funding, and must be coordinated with City staff.
