Breakfast in Bobcaygeon

Start your day off on the right foot and with a full stomach! There are several delicious and unique breakfast choices in Bobcaygeon. Below are some great suggestions:

Enjoy a traditional breakfast at the Daylight Diner - 80 Bolton Street

Explore the Bobcaygeon Doors Open Sites

Boyd Heritage Museum - 21 Canal Street East

Experience the history of Bobcaygeon and the life and legacy of the Boyd family!

Edgewood Dry Stone Wall - 28 Boyd Street

Built in 1890 and restored in 2021, discover this iconic drystone wall that mimics those in Ireland and once served as landscaping on the W.T.C. Boyd Estate.

Christ Anglican Church - 43 Sherwood Street

Designed by Irish architect John Belcher, the Christ Anglican Church celebrated its first service with the Bobcaygeon community on Christmas Eve, 1870!

Fenelon Station Gallery - 103 Lindsay Street

Located in the 1880s Fenelon Falls train station, come take a look at some really beautiful art and support our local artists!

Fenelon Falls Generating Station

Located at Lock 34 of the Trent-Severn Waterway. Meet by the stairs on the east side of Lindsay Street, adjacent to the falls.

Originally built in 1893 and rebuilt in 1997, this generating station supplies electricity to approximately 2,000 homes in Kawartha Lakes!

Maryboro Lodge Museum - 50 Oak Street

Visit this fun, interactive museum while learning all about the community of Fenelon Falls and the legacy of James Wallis!
