

My Mom's Butter-Scotch Pie

This recipe is a cherished family tradition, passed down through the Lowes family, originating from my grandmother Mary's lineage.

Michael and Margaret Lowes (née Monaghan) immigrated from Ireland to Ontario in the mid-1850s. The Lowes family acquired Concession 7, Lot 17 in the former Township of Emily from Thomas Groves, a Peter Robinson immigrant.

Michael and Margaret had one son, William (born 1856). William married Sarah Ann Kerr, also of Emily Township, in 1887 and together they raised five children, one of whom was my grandmother, in the original log cabin built by the Groves family.

Recipe

Ingredients:

2 egg yoks
2 tablespoons of flour
2 cups milk
3 tablespoon cornstarch
1 cup brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
3 tablespoons butter

Mix everything together in a pot on the stove and it thickens.

When ready, pour mixture into a baked pie shell.

Serve with whipped cream.
