



Pool - In ground or Above ground – Municipal Bylaw

Owner Authorization – If you are applying on behalf of the owner, you and the owner, will need to complete and sign.

Site Plan – a site plan showing the location of the proposed pool and its pumping, filtration and heating equipment, including dimensions and setbacks, if the grade of the land is to be altered, a description of the remedial measures to be taken to avoid changing existing drainage patterns; and any additional information required by the City to determine whether the proposed swimming pool complies with this and any other applicable by-laws.

Regional Conservation Authority Approval (If Applicable) – if your property is subject to Conservation Authority Regulation, contact them for an approval/permit or written exemption from appropriate Conservation Authority, prior to submitting your application for building permit.
