- 40 lb/18 kg maximum per bag.
- No more than 10% of recyclables allowed per bag.



Recycling refreshers for 2024:

Blue Box changes are coming: The Ontario government is implementing a province wide program that makes producers of products and packaging responsible for recycling the materials they supply. As of April 1, 2024, Kawartha Lakes' residential recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials. As we receive more information, updates will be posted on the Extended Producer Responsibility page on our website: www.kawarthalakes.ca/EPR

Mattress recycling: Thanks to your help, to date our mattress recycling program has diverted over 25,000 mattresses from ending up in our landfills! If you need to recycle an old mattress or box spring, please note that the only landfill that accepts mattresses is the Lindsay Landfill. Can't get to the landfill? Buy a Curbside Tag to have it picked up at your home (see November to learn more).

Bulky plastics: In April 2023, Council made the Bulky Plastic Recycling Pilot Program permanent. To date we've diverted over 100 tonnes of bulky plastics from our landfills. Help us top it this year by recycling your bulky plastic items at the **Lindsay Landfill for free**. The program is available at the Lindsay Landfill only.

Here's a quick refresher on what to do with your household waste and recycling:

- Waste must be set out in clear bags and contain less than 10% of recyclable items. Bags must weigh less than 40lb (18 kg).
- Waste/recycling must be set out by 7am on your day of collection (6am in designated downtown areas). There is no "usual" pick-up time; getting your waste out by 7am will ensure that it gets picked up.
- Residential units are allowed an unlimited number of recycling bins (max bin size = 22 gallons). Recycling must be loose in bins.
- Waste storage bins must have a flagging device (similar to a mailbox) to alert collection staff that there are materials inside to be collected.
- Stretchy plastic film (grocery, bread, produce, etc.) must be bundled inside a small clear bag, tied shut and placed in your container recycling bin.
- Rinse your containers of any leftover foods.

Renovation season is gearing up! Did you know the municipality operates a mixed construction and demolition waste diversion program for residents? The program diverted over 1,000 tonnes of material from our landfill in its first year of existence, and the goal is to increase that tonnage every year! The collected material will be recycled to help reduce waste and extend the life of the landfill. Regular tipping fees will apply.

- All residents are welcome to use this program.
- The program is only available at the Lindsay Landfill.
- Material must be loose (no bagged materials).
- Materials that can be included in the program: drywall, gypsum, shingles, cabinets, counters, clean wood, porcelain (toilets and sinks), windows, bricks, vinyl siding and concrete.
- Materials that cannot be included in the program: garbage, hazardous waste, pressure treated wood, metal, mattresses and rolls of carpet. If you're disposing of these items at the same time, they must be separated and disposed of in the municipality's other waste/ recycling programs accordingly.

In order to receive waste/recycling collection, private, seasonal and unassumed roads must be properly maintained. Waste and recycling will not be collected if the driver deems the road unsafe for travel. All roads must follow the standards outlined in By-Law 2016-144 in order to receive collection. Please keep the following in mind to avoid any delays in service:

- Have the road plowed to a minimum of 4m/12ft wide.
- Sand or salt the road when needed.
- Make sure vegetation is cut back to a minimum of 5m/15ft high and 4m/12ft wide.
- Fill and grade potholes when needed.
- Provide a suitable turnaround area for the collection truck.
- Waste storage bins must have a flagging device (similar to a mailbox) to alert collection staff when there are materials inside to be collected.

Seasonal collection resumes May 6 and ends October 25. For any questions regarding collection on private, seasonal and unassumed roads, please visit www.kawarthalakes.ca/waste



Our landfills are always busiest in the summer, especially on Saturdays! Now you can **know before you go** by checking the line-up camera at the Lindsay Landfill before you leave home: www.kawarthalakes.ca/landfills

Follow these steps when visiting our landfills:

- Immediately report to the scale house where an attendant will be happy to help you.
- Follow all attendant instructions, signs and directions.
- Ensure your waste is in clear bags or loose (black or opaque bags will be charged at a mixed load rate).
- If you don't know where a certain material goes, ask a landfill attendant for help.
- After you drop off your material, return to the scale house to weigh out and get your receipt.
- Always scale in and scale out. Even though your load might be free, we still need to capture the weight of the materials you're leaving behind.

Please remember that Kawartha Lakes has a **zero tolerance** policy for violence or harassment. Unruly behaviour will not be tolerated and could result in tipping privileges being revoked. Finally, on your way out, be sure to thank the staff for the amazing job they do in keeping Kawartha Lakes green!


Did you know that 95% of all textiles (clothing, footwear and linen) are fully recyclable, yet 85% of them end up in landfills? There's an estimated 500 million pounds of textiles rotting away in Canadian landfills. Textile waste puts a tremendous strain on the environment. As it decomposes, it releases methane gas, which is a harmful greenhouse gas and significant contributor to global warming.

In an effort to divert textile waste from our landfills, we've partnered with Recycling Rewards to offer residents of Kawartha Lakes two free curbside textile recycling pick-ups a year (June and October). Residents must call or email Recycling Rewards in advance to put themselves on the list for pick-up. If you miss the curbside collection windows, you can always bring your textile recycling to one of the free textile recycling bins at our five landfills.

Please note that all textiles must be in a clear plastic bag. Used clothing, footwear and linens will all be accepted. Ripped or stained items will be accepted for recycling.

It's free to take your household hazardous waste to the Fenelon or Lindsay Landfills! Items accepted include automotive products, batteries, paints and solvents, household products, empty tanks and containers, personal care products, products that contain mercury, pesticides and fertilizers.

For each category listed above, there is a 55lb (25kg) weight limit per customer per day. Due to the weight limits, residents are asked to bring small loads of household hazardous waste to the depots when they come. Quantities greater than the limit may not be accepted in one trip.

Our Waste Management team also goes out to the community four times per year to host Round Up Days. Meet our staff in your community to dispose of bulky plastics, household hazardous waste, textiles and electronics (new this year) for **free**. The events are hosted in the summer in Bobcaygeon, Carden, Coboconk and Manvers. Learn more: www.kawarthalakes.ca/roundupdays

Commercial hazardous waste (produced by a business) will not be accepted at our depots or Round Up Days.



Curbside Textile Recycling Pick-up - October 7 to 10

Save yourself a trip to the landfill! Did you know that the municipality offers a number of curbside programs to help you manage your waste without having to even leave your driveway?

All of the following **free** special collection events happen twice a year:

- Curbside battery (March and November)
- Curbside textile recycling (June and October)
- Curbside leaf and yard (June and November)

For a small fee (\$10 to \$20 per tag) we also offer curbside pick up of **large items** (old appliances, furniture, electronics, toilets, etc.), **Freon appliances** (fridge, air conditioner, freezer, etc.), and **mattresses/box springs**. All you need to do is purchase the appropriate curbside tag.

Buy the curbside tags online www.kawarthalakes.ca/ curbsidetags or visit one of our Municipal Service Centres to buy your tags in person.

There's a Source Separated Organics (SSO) program coming soon to Kawartha Lakes.

SSO is essentially food and organic waste; 30% or more of household waste is considered SSO. Every year households in Kawartha Lakes fill up 28,000 cubic metres (more than 11 Olympic-sized swimming pools) worth of landfill space with an estimated 4,500 tonnes of SSO waste. A successful SSO program will help us get closer to reaching our goal of diverting 70% of waste from our landfills by 2048.

We are hoping to offer an SSO program to all residents in the coming years. In the meantime, we continue to encourage you to compost as a way to manage food waste at home. Composters and digesters can be purchased at our Municipal Service Centres. For more information visit: www.kawarthalakes.ca/compost



Landfill locations


There are five landfills in Kawartha Lakes:

LINDSAY: North-east of Lindsay, off CKL Rd 36. Going north, turn left (west) onto Wilson Road (at first bend past the site of the correctional facility). Landfill is 0.5 km on the left hand (west) side. Address: 51 Wilson Road LANDFILL (35) 47 LINDSAY 17/ 19/









To ensure your visit to a landfill is quick and convenient:

- 1. Stop at the scale house on arrival for instructions
- 2. Follow instructions carefully (ask again, if necessary)
- 3. Pay attention to all site signage
- 4. Once material drop off is complete, return to the scale house to check out

When not in operation, access to landfill sites is restricted. Charges for trespassing will be laid.

Winter Landfill Hours • October 16 to April 30 • Hours may be subject to change based on operational requirements. All landfills are closed New Year's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day. Lindsay Landfill is the only landfill scheduled to operate on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, it will be open from 8am to 12pm, all other landfills will be closed.
