

Personal Support Worker

Reporting to the Registered Nurse, a Personal Support Worker (PSW) is a key member of the support team in a long term care setting. PSWs provide personal care services in accordance with an established plan of care, assists residents with physical needs such as personal care (bathing, dressing, etc.), as well as getting around the home.

PSWs add to the quality of life of residents and give emotional support and friendship. PSWs are an important part of a resident's health-care team because they know their residents well and can report any behaviour or clinical changes.

Personal Support Worker Certificate is a requirement.
