

What goes where?

Important note: All items being recycled need to be rinsed out/cleaned of any food/drink/waste residue. All unclean recycling will end up as regular waste. Broken glass should not be placed in your blue bin. Please set it out in a tightly sealed cardboard box labelled "Broken Glass" for disposal as waste. Organics separation only impacts households in the urban areas of Bobcaygeon, Fenelon Falls, Omemee and Lindsay.

Residential Household



Waste and recycling must be set out at the curb **by 7am.**



Weekly limit of 2 bags of waste, at a maximum weight of 40 lb. each.



Unlimited recycling, items loose and in containers 22 gal. or less. No bagged recycling.

Commercial



6am in Downtown Lindsay, Bobcaygeon and Fenelon Falls. 7am for all other locations.



Weekly limit of 4 bags of waste, at a maximum weight of 40 lb. each.



4 bundled cubic yards (cardboard) or 4 roll-out carts. No bagged recycling.
