Time to explore the Fenelon Falls Doors Open Sites!



Site 1: The Grove Theatre - 27 Veterans Way

The Grove Theatre is a one-of-a-kind performance venue in Kawartha Lakes that opened in the summer of 2022. This outdoor amphitheatre hosts an annual lineup of its own theatre productions alongside appearances from Canadian guest artists, community events, and a drama camp for young people.

Site 2: The Fenelon Station Gallery - 103 Lindsay Street

Located in the 1880s Fenelon Falls train station, come take a look at some really beautiful art and support our local artists!

Site 3: The Fenelon Falls Generating Station

Located on the east side of the Fenelon Falls bridge, this site was originally built in 1893 and rebuilt in 1997. It is home to a generating station that supplies electricity to approximately 2,000 homes in Kawartha Lakes!

Site 4: Fenelon Falls United Church - 123 Colborne Street

Take a look inside this beautiful church that has been serving the community since 1911. Just like Fenelon Falls, this church is also celebrating an anniversary! The Woodstock organ within the church is celebrating 100 years since its installation!

Site 5: Kawartha Lakes Fire Station 22 - 9 John Street

Join us at Kawartha Lakes Fire Station 22 in Fenelon Falls and meet the firefighters! Learn about the work these firefighters do and the equipment and vehicles they use.

Site 6: St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church - 89 Colborne Street

Explore St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church - the second Presbyterian church in Fenelon Falls was constructed in 1895.

Hours: 11am to 4pm

Site 7: Maryboro Lodge Museum - 50 Oak Street

Visit this fun, interactive museum while learning all about the community of Fenelon Falls and the legacy of James Wallis!
