

Statement of Eligibility

Important: This ballot belongs to the person listed on the Voter Information Letter and should not be used by anyone else.

You can vote in the 2022 Kawartha Lakes Municipal Election if you are:

- 1. a Canadian Citizen; and,
- 2. At least 18 years old; and,
- 3. A Kawartha Lakes resident, property owner, or tenant (or the spouse of one); and,
- 4. Legally allowed to vote.

Under the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, it is illegal to:

- 1. Vote when you are not an eligible Kawartha Lakes voter;
- 2. Vote with more than one ballot:
- 3. Give or sell your Voter Information Letter, Voting PIN or ballot to someone else;
- 4. Take someone else's Voter Information Letter, Voting PIN or ballot;
- 5. Vote with someone else's Voting PIN or ballot;
- Force someone to vote in any way;
- 7. Bribe someone to vote in any way;
- 8. Accept a bribe to vote in any way;
- 9. Invade the privacy of someone who is voting;
- 10. Intentionally reveal how someone else has voted;
- 11. Stop someone from voting;
- 12. Lie to or mislead an Election Official; or,
- 13. Try to do any of the above.

If you do any of the above, you could be fined up to \$25,000 and serve up to 6 months in jail.
